Scope of Practice

The Sudbury Manitoulin Abortion Support Collective is a non-partisan, 2SLGBTQIA+ inclusive organization of volunteers aiming to provide confidential, free support and advocacy for persons in need of abortion in the Greater Sudbury and Manitoulin Island district to ensure full access. We are in Robinson-Huron Treaty territory and the land on which we gather is the traditional territory of the Anishnaabeg. There are many barriers in the current Canadian healthcare system which actively prevent and hinder those who require abortions. We want to ease that burden.

We offer:

- emotional support
- rides to and from healthcare appointments
- support during doctor's visits (such as, note taking, water, tissues, and a list of questions to ask any medical professionals)
- information regarding community resources

We cannot:

- give medical care or diagnoses
- provide clinical procedures
- interpret medical diagnoses
- interpret clinical results
- prescribe or administer medical treatment
- provide medical service
- provide therapies of any kind
- make decisions for you
- speak for you
- transport family members/partners/pets
- childcare
